

## SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

*Vintage Church: All of Jesus*

*Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles (Acts 2:43, NIV).*

### OPENING PRAYER TIME

Pray that God would open your hearts to Him, and that you would experience a holy sense of His presence.

### OPENING DISCUSSION QUESTION(S)

1. When the Bible talks about signs and wonders, what are they talking about? Share some examples from scripture, and maybe from your own life or someone close to you.

### SERMON/BIBLE DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

2. Read Acts 2:42-43 together discussing observations from the past 2 weeks and sharing how you have devoted yourselves.
3. What does devoting ourselves to the Word of God, to fellowship, the breaking of bread, and to prayer have to do with signs and wonders, and our ability to experience them?
4. What does it mean to have radical faith, and how is this different than regular faith?  
***“For we walk by faith, not by sight” (2 Corinthians 5:7, ESV).***
5. The disciples walked and lived with Jesus, experienced and even performed many miracles for three years and still had doubts. What does this mean for us, and how does this change for us as believers filled with the Holy Spirit? Can we still have doubts, and if so, how do we handle them?
6. Read ***Matthew 9:16-17*** together and discuss what this verse means for us today. What was Jesus teaching His disciples and what does He want us to learn about His new covenant, and our new life that can only be found in Him?
7. Look up the following verses together and discuss how this applies to our new lives in Christ, and the work of His Holy Spirit in our lives. ***John 3:3; Titus 3:5; 1 Peter 1:23***  
What does this have to do with the community and the vintage church?  
***“Therefore, if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new” (2 Cor. 5:17).***
8. What did Pastor Andy mean when he talked about Godly community is found with godly people? Do some self-evaluation together as a group and discuss. What does your community look like? You may not be experiencing “signs and wonders” everyday and that’s ok, but are you seeing movements of God? If not, what needs to change?
9. The fullness of God can be simplified to this phrase “all of Jesus.” What would it look like for the church to position itself to receive, “all of Jesus”?

10. What does all of this mean for us as a church, the body of Christ? How can we stop “playing church” or just going through the motions day after day and week after week, and start being a people of radical faith who serve a radical God?

*CLOSING PRAYER TIME*

Take some time at the end of your group and seek the presence of God, asking for the Holy Spirit to guide you and lead you, opening up your heart to His will.
